



## University World Tour: December 2020

With in-person networking events on hold, and many educators now suffering from the “Zoom-fatigue” of virtual presentations and webinars, we are pleased to announce our **University World Tour** - a series of intimate, interactive online events designed to facilitate conversation between counselors and university reps from all over the world.

You'll have the chance to not only build up your network, but also gain inside knowledge about each university, and get answers to the pressing questions on your/your students' minds.

### How to register

As these are small events, each one is limited to 18 counselors. If the tickets sell out, you will be able to join a waiting list and will receive an email if someone cancels their registration.

### How will it work?

First, we'll be using Zoom breakout rooms in a “speed-networking” format, so you can chat to each rep, and ask them any questions.

Counselors will be in groups of 1-3 and will be put into a Zoom breakout room where they will remain for the first part of the event. Each university rep will then join the room for 12 minutes. You will get to speak with all university reps in attendance.

Then, we will share links to individual university reps' Zoom rooms, so you can carry on the conversation if you wish to do so.

### Who's invited?

These events are available exclusively to BridgeU counselors and university reps. The full list of university reps attending will be available prior to the event.

## How to prepare

While these sessions are designed to be quite informal, here are our tips to help you make the most of the event:

1. Come with a goal in mind. What do you want to find out?
2. Do some research on the universities attending. Do you have any students applying to these universities, and what questions might they have?
3. Make a list of any time-sensitive topics you want to get information on, e.g. how COVID-19 has impacted the learning environment.
4. Have some information ready about your school to share with the university reps. Which curriculum do you use? Where are most of your students applying? Do you have past alumni at the university?
